| 1st station | Visitation of a sustainable project of solid waste management in a municipality. The procedure is a continuous anaerobic digestion in the plug low digester (kompogas) for biological waste, grass and other herbaceous residues. | 09.30 | 11.15 |

| 2nd station | Is a typical agricultural AD-plant which runs since 2009 on a agricultural farm. Its original installed capacity was 75kW and represents now 185kW. The plant ferments about 60% grassilage and has got a boiler for the fermentation substrat between the first stage and the second stage of fermentation which boosts the process. A separation for the digestate is also installed. | 11.55 | 13.15 |

| | Bus trip from Oberauerbach to Kusel | 14.35 | 15.20 |
| 3rd station | Visit of 330 KWel biogas plant for the treatment of communal green cuttings, grass from set aside areas and energy crops in batch dry fermentation method (bekon) with 8 boxes. The produced heat is used in a container system for drying of wood. Thus this utilisation of the heat improves the economy of the AD plant. | 15.20 | 16.50 |

During the study tour, locations will be visited where innovative value chains for biogas from grass residues are being tested at pilot scale or have already been fully implemented.
